

Three Paintings by Fred Aspinwall

By Richard Lanyon, December 2024. These painting have been in my possession for several years. All three came to me from my cousin in Whittier, California in the 1980s and have been in storage ever since. I have given them names and all three are signed by Fred Aspinwall, my maternal grandfather.

Desert Landscape, framed, oils on fiber board, art work size is 24 inches high by 32 inches wide, signed Fred Aspinwall, 1832. The year is obviously in error and should be 1932. It was painted while Fred was visiting his daughter and family in Los Angeles County, California.

Flowers and Vase Near Window, not framed, oils on a wood panel, 13 by 13 inches, signed F Aspinwall, 1891. This was painted in Fred's living space before he left London for the USA.

Flowers in Square Cut Glass Vase, framed, art work is 32 inches high by 24 inches wide, signed F Aspinwall, 1932. It was probably painted in Fred's home in the Woodlawn neighborhood in Chicago. I recall seeing the vase in my parent's home when I was an adolescent.
